What can I teach with a Broad Field Language Arts license?

The Broad Field Language Arts license holders may teach any language arts subject at the EA-A level up through grade 10, and any basic fusion language arts subjects in grades 11-12 that is NOT:

- A semester-long discrete course in a PI 34 language arts category (e.g. Speech Communication, Journalism, or English)
- An honors, International Baccalaureate (IB), or Advanced Placement (AP) course
- Part of the college preparatory sequence and/or an elective course with more depth of content than basic courses.

To teach a course under criteria 1, 2, or 3 above, the teacher must hold a license based on completion of at least a concentration in that subject.
