Student Teaching requirements: Must student teach in two developmental levels (MS & HS) and at least two different science subject areas

What can I teach with a Broad Field Science license?

The license holder may teach any science subjects at the early adolescence – adolescence level, up through grade 10, and any basic or fusion science class in grades 11-12 that is NOT:

- a) A semester-long discrete course in a PI 34 science category (e.g. Life and Environmental Science (606))
- b) An honor, International Baccalaureate (IB), or Advanced Placement (AP) course
- c) Part of the college preparatory sequence and/or an elective course with more depth of content than basic courses.

To teach a course under the criteria a, b or c above, the teacher must hold a license based on completion of at least a concentration in that subject area.
